FUNERAL SERVICE

This service package includes one day of gathering at Turner & Porter with a funeral ceremony. Visitation hours may be tailored to each family's needs.

It includes professional staff supervision and the use of a visitation suite including equipment required to display personal items and floral tributes. Your family and friends are welcome to make use of our shared cafe at no additional cost.

LIFE CELEBRATION GATHERING

This service package includes one day of gathering at Turner & Porter without a formal ceremony. Visitation hours may be tailored to each family's needs.

It includes professional staff supervision and the use of a visitation suite including equipment required to display personal items and floral tributes. Should your family wish, a variety of food and beverage options are available.

DIRECT BURIAL OR CREMATION

This service package includes minimal burial or cremation arrangements.

These services include the use of our service vehicle for private transport of the deceased to the cemetery or crematorium. Family members are not present for the burial or cremation.

The above list of packages reflects those most commonly selected in our community, however, is certainly not a complete list of the options available. Should your family's needs differ from the options listed below, we welcome you to speak to one of our funeral directors.

PROFESSIONAL AND STAFF SERVICES

BASIC PROFESSIONAL FEES

Professional consultation with licensed funeral personnel, which may include expert advice on options to meet your needs, including essential services relating to disposition, planning and scheduling ceremonies, advice regarding possible government benefits. This service also includes, but is not limited to, staffing, cleaning and maintenance of premises and grounds, staffing office and telephone coverage. It includes the maintenance of permanent records, accounting, legal, advertising and public awareness fees. A Basic Professional Fee is payable whenever we are providing services to you.

COORDINATING RITES AND CEREMONIES

Coordination of all rites and ceremonies, before, during and after they have been provided. This would include the coordinating and directing the services of our staff and agents with those of the hospital, nursing home, cemetery or crematorium in transferring the deceased from the place of death and making the necessary arrangements for final disposition. This service includes, but is not limited to, making the necessary arrangements for clergy, officiants, musicians, and preparations for final disposition. Also including, such ordering for customized urns, vaults, flowers, memorial printing, and receptions on behalf of the purchaser.

DOCUMENTATION - PERMITS, FORMS, ETC.

Completion and filing of all documents necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested, including but not limited to, death registration, burial permit, coroner's certificate for cremation. As part of this service, we will provide you with Proof of Death certificates; such certificates are usually accepted for most estate settlement purposes, but sometimes a provincial death certificate will be necessary and available through the Office of the Register General.

TRANSPORT REMAINS

Transport of the remains from one place to another, for example the hospital, nursing home, hospice or residence to our premises (within 50 km.). This service is available, if necessary, 24 hours daily and includes a second staff member, when required, at no additional cost.

BASIC PREPARATION OF REMAINS

The preparation of the body for placement into the casket, including disinfection and bathing, dressing and setting of facial features for identification or viewing without embalming.

PROFESSIONAL PREPARATION AND EMBALMING

The vascular embalming and preservation of the deceased for the purpose of completing funeral, religious and cultural rituals. Turner & Porter requires professional embalming if there is to be public viewing.

STAFF SERVICES FOR VISITATION

Staff to coordinate and oversee the visitation (informal gathering) at our premises for one or two days. Suggested visitation times are 2–4 and 7–9 p.m.

STAFF SERVICES FOR CEREMONY

Staff to coordinate and oversee the ceremony. This service includes, but is not limited to, the services of a licensed funeral director and assistants for the preparation for the ceremony including the arrangement of the casket and/ or urn, floral tributes, photographs and memorabilia and the conducting of the ceremony including the direction of family members and guests.

STAFF SERVICES FOR RECEPTION

One hostess for the set-up of reception equipment, coffee, tea and punch along with any other requested refreshments for up to 50 guests at a Turner & Porter reception facility. Service is based on reception lasting up to 90 minutes (\$50 additional for each $\frac{1}{2}$ hour beyond the first 90 minutes). For receptions larger than 50 people a second hostess is required.

FACILITY CHARGES

BASIC FACILITIES

Use of our general and common areas. – parking lot, washrooms, cloakrooms, heating, lighting, maintenance. This charge applies whenever we provide services to you.

FACILITIES TO SHELTER THE REMAINS

Facilities used to prepare, embalm and/or shelter the body; this charge applies whenever the body is in our facility for any purpose. After two days, additional fees of \$50 per day may apply.

FACILITIES FOR VISITATION

Designated facilities and equipment used for visitation for one or two days. Includes public lounge facilities and parking.

FACILITIES FOR CEREMONY (*ONSITE) (OR ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS *OFFSITE)

Designated Chapel facilities at Turner & Porter used for the ceremony. For offsite funerals this fee applies and reflects the additional time and equipment requirements when the ceremony is not held at a Turner & Porter location.

RECEPTION FACILITIES

Use of facilities at Turner & Porter for a reception following the ceremony, which includes the reception room for a period of up to 90 minutes, all applicable equipment such as linens, cups, saucers, plates, coffee and tea urns, etc. (\$75 for each $\frac{1}{2}$ hour beyond the first 90 minutes).

EQUIPMENT & VEHICLE CHARGES

TRANSFER VEHICLE

Use of specialized vehicle and equipment to transfer the remains from the place of death to the funeral home.

FUNERAL COACH

Use of specialized vehicle, equipment and chauffer includes the transportation of the casket from the funeral home to the cemetery / crematorium or to the church or other place of service within a 50 km radius for a three hour period (\$75 each additional ½ hour)._____\$400.

FAMILY CAR - 7 PASSENGER

Use of specialized vehicle and chauffer includes the transportation of family members to the funeral home or church for the funeral service and cemetery / crematorium or to the church or other place of service within a 50 km radius for a four hour period (\$75 each additional $\frac{1}{2}$ hour).

FAMILY CAR - 4 PASSENGER

Use of specialized vehicle and chauffer includes the transportation of family members to the funeral home or church for the funeral service and cemetery / crematorium or to the church or other place of service within a 50 km radius for a four hour period (\$40 each additional $\frac{1}{2}$ hour).

SERVICE VEHICLE

Use of specialized vehicle, equipment and chauffer includes the private transportation of the remains from the funeral home to the cemetery / crematorium within a 50 km radius.

GENERAL DUTY VEHICLE

The use of this vehicle and driver may include the delivery of flowers to the cemetery or crematorium for committal prayers. Additionally, this vehicle may be used to deliver flowers to local churches, institutions and the family residence, clergy call for, registration of the death.


VAULT SELECTIONS

A burial vault provides a secure environment for the casket and the physical remains contained within the casket. Placement of a burial vault within a gravesite substantially reduces, and virtually eliminates settling and assists in providing protection from gravesite elements.

DISBURSEMENTS

Disbursements are additional services not related to Turner & Porter, however are often selected when completing funeral arrangements. As a courtesy, many times Turner & Porter is able to carry these fees on your behalf. All disbursement fees are charged at cost and payment for these items is required at the time the contract is entered into. The following represent some common third party costs but depending upon circumstance others may apply.

CREMATION/INTERMENT FEE

CORONER'S DECLARATION FOR CREMATION – a fee set by the Chief Coroner for Ontario for the issuing of a certificate that allows cremation to take place.

MUNICIPAL DEATH REGISTRATION FEE - a fee set by individual municipalities to register the death.

BEREAVEMENT AUTHORITY OF ONTARIO CONSUMER PROTECTION FEE – The fee is charged by the Bereavement Authority of Ontario (BAO) in order to provide its services of information on bereavement services and to regulate the profession.

CLERGY & CHURCH HONORARIUM – this is an amount paid for the clergy and/or church for the use of their facilities.

CHURCH ORGANIST/SOLOIST HONORARIUM – this is an amount paid to musicians/performers for their services. In most circumstances this is a fee set by the individual musicians/performers.

NEWSPAPER DEATH ANNOUNCEMENT – these are charges for death announcements placed in newspapers as a notification of the death and any pertinent details of visitation and/or ceremony. Fees are charged on a per line basis and are set by the individual newspapers.

FUNERAL PREPAYMENT OPTIONS

At Turner & Porter, there are benefits you may wish to consider when arranging a funeral in advance:

1. TO PREPAY BY MEANS OF TRUST ACCOUNT

A Prepaid Guaranteed Funeral Contract is completed with all costs itemized. Funds received are deposited through Guaranteed Funeral Deposits of Canada (Fraternal).

2. TO PREPAY BY MEANS OF INSURANCE

A prepaid guaranteed funeral contract is complete with all costs itemized. Funds received are deposited either in full or on payment plans in a group annuity.

3. TO MAKE PARTIAL PAYMENTS

To suit your budget, insured and non-insured multi-year payment plans are available.

With either prepayment option, if you have prepaid the guaranteed funeral contract in full, the interest that accumulates on the prepaid funds is applied to the total cost of the funeral at the time of need. Any excess funds will be returned to the estate of the deceased person. If the funeral has been fully prepaid and there are not sufficient funds when the services are provided, Turner & Porter will absorb the shortfall as the funeral has been guaranteed as described in the contract.

4. DEPOSIT OPTION

Amount is placed in Trust and applied to expenses at the time of need with accumulated interest.

5. TO PREARRANGE WITHOUT PREPAYING

All of your instructions are on file at the Turner & Porter Chapel of your choice. The funeral services are provided at the time of need with the price schedules in effect when the death occurs.

6. AWAY FROM HOME PLAN

OTHER CONSUMER BENEFITS TO PRE PAYING YOUR PLAN IN ADVANCE WITH A LICENSED FUNERAL HOME

- Modifiable if wishes change, like a last will
- Transferable if you move
- Tax Free Grown (EFA eligable funeral account, much like a TFSA)
