FUNERAL SERVICE IN THE CHAPEL OR CHURCH WITH ONE OR TWO DAYS OF VISITATION

This service package includes one or two scheduled periods of visitation at a Turner & Porter location. It includes professional staff supervision and the use of a visitation suite including equipment required to display personal items and floral tributes. On the day of the funeral service, our professional staff will guide your family through the many aspects of the funeral day. It would include the use of our facilities, equipment and vehicles to host your service at a Turner & Porter facility or the assistance and direction of our staff at a church or other location. Turner & Porter's staff will also accompany your family to the deceased's final resting place. This service package also includes the professional embalming, preparation and dressing of the deceased and may include restorative or hairdressing services at no additional cost.

SERVICE PACKAGE B

FUNERAL SERVICE IN THE CHAPEL OR CHURCH WITH VISITATION ONE HOUR PRIOR TO SERVICE

This service package includes visitation held on the same day as the service; typically one hour prior to the service start time. On the day of the funeral service, our professional staff will guide your family through the many aspects of the funeral day. It would include the use of our facilities, equipment and vehicles to host your service at a Turner & Porter facility or the assistance and direction of our staff at a church or other location. Turner & Porter's staff will also accompany your family to the deceased's final resting place. This service package also includes the professional embalming, preparation and dressing of the deceased and may include restorative or hairdressing services at no additional cost. Same day funeral services and visitation are commonly selected when a small number of guests are anticipated or the funeral is private for family and invited friends.

SERVICE PACKAGE C

SERVICE OF REMEMBRANCE IN THE CHAPEL WITH VISITATION ONE HOUR PRIOR TO SERVICE (NO CASKET PRESENT)

This service package includes visitation held on the same day as the service; typically one hour prior to the service start time. On the day of the Service of Remembrance, our professional staff will guide your family through the many aspects of the service day. It would include the use of our facilities, equipment and vehicles to host your service at a Turner & Porter facility. This service package represents having the deceased's urn present for the service instead of their casket. Although the deceased's body is not present, experience shows that many of our families gather for a private viewing in advance of the cremation.

All vehicle charges are based within a 50 km. radius, and three-hour maximum. Additional distance and/or time charges will apply beyond these parameters.

It is the policy of Turner & Porter that human remains be identified to a member of our staff.

The identification may be made by a relative, friend, neighbour, co-worker, or clergy person.

We feel that this is important and we provide this service at no additional charge.

PROFESSIONAL AND STAFF SERVICES

BASIC PROFESSIONAL FEES

Professional consultation with licensed funeral personnel, which may include expert advice on options to meet your needs, including essential services relating to disposition, planning and scheduling ceremonies, advising regarding possible government benefits. This service also includes, but is not limited to, staffing, cleaning and maintenance of premises and grounds, staffing office and telephone coverage. It includes the maintenance of permanent records, accounting, legal, advertising and public awareness fees. A Basic Professional Fee is payable whenever we are providing services to you.

COORDINATING RITES AND CEREMONIES

Coordination of all rites and ceremonies, before, during and after they have been provided. This would include the coordinating and directing the services of our staff and agents with those of the hospital, nursing home, cemetery or crematorium in transferring the deceased from the place of death and making the necessary arrangements for final disposition. This service includes, but is not limited to, making the necessary arrangements for clergy, officiants, musicians, and preparations for final disposition. Also including, such ordering for customized urns, vaults, flowers, memorial printing, and receptions on behalf of the purchaser.

DOCUMENTATION – PERMITS, FORMS, ETC.

Completion and filing of all documents necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested, including but not limited to, death registration, burial permit, coroner's certificate for cremation. As part of this service, we will provide you with Proof of Death certificates; such certificates are usually accepted for most estate settlement purposes, but sometimes a provincial death certificate will be necessary and available through the Office of the Register General.

TRANSPORT REMAINS

Transport of the remains from one place to another, for example the hospital, nursing home, hospice or residence to our premises (within 50 km.). This service is available, if necessary, 24 hours daily and includes a second staff member, when required, at no additional cost.

BASIC PREPARATION OF REMAINS

The preparation of the body for placement into the casket, including disinfection and bathing, dressing and setting of facial features for identification or viewing without embalming.

PROFESSIONAL PREPARATION AND EMBALMING

The vascular embalming and preservation of the deceased for the purpose of completing funeral, religious and cultural rituals. Turner & Porter requires professional embalming if there is to be public viewing.

STAFF SERVICES FOR VISITATION

Staff to coordinate and oversee the visitation (informal gathering) at our premises for one or two days. Suggested visitation times are 2–4 and 7–9 p.m.

STAFF SERVICES FOR CEREMONY

Staff to coordinate and oversee the ceremony. This service includes, but is not limited to, the services of a licensed funeral director and assistants for the preparation for the ceremony including the arrangement of the casket and/ or urn, floral tributes, photographs and memorabilia and the conducting of the ceremony including the direction of family members and quests.

Designated Chapel facilities at Turner & Porter used for the ceremony. For offsite funerals this fee applies and reflects the additional time and equipment requirements when the ceremony is not held at a Turner & Porter location.

Use of specialized vehicle and chauffer includes the transportation of family members to the funeral home orchurch for the funeral service and cemetery / crematorium or to the church or other place of service within a 50 kmradius for a four hour period (\$40 each additional $\frac{1}{2}$ hour).

Use of specialized vehicle, equipment and chauffer includes the private transportation of the remains from the funeral home to the cemetery / crematorium within a 50 km radius.



VAULT SELECTIONS

A burial vault provides a secure environment for the casket and the physical remains contained within the casket. Placement of a burial vault within a gravesite substantially reduces, and virtually eliminates settling and assists in providing protection from gravesite elements.

DISBURSEMENTS

Disbursements are additional services not related to Turner & Porter, however are often selected when completing funeral arrangements. As a courtesy, many times Turner & Porter is able to carry these fees on your behalf. All disbursement fees are charged at cost and payment for these items is required at the time the contract is entered into. The following represent some common third party costs but depending upon circumstance others may apply.

CORONER'S DECLARATION FOR CREMATION – a fee set by the Chief Coroner for Ontario for the issuing of a certificate that allows cremation to take place.

MUNICIPAL DEATH REGISTRATION FEE - a fee set by individual municipalities to register the death.

CHURCH HONORARIUM – this is an amount paid to the church for the use of their facilities. In some cases it includes the services of the clergy as well.

CLERGY HONORARIUM - this is an amount paid to the clergy or person who facilitates the service or ceremony.

CHURCH ORGANIST/SOLOIST HONORARIUM – this is an amount paid to musicians/performers for their services. In most circumstances this is a fee set by the individual musicians/performers.

NEWSPAPER DEATH ANNOUNCEMENT – these are charges for death announcements placed in newspapers as a notification of the death and any pertinent details of visitation and/or ceremony. Fees are charged on a per line basis and are set by the individual newspapers.

FUNERAL PREPAYMENT OPTIONS

At Turner & Porter, there are four options you may wish to consider when arranging a funeral in advance:

1. TO PREPAY BY MEANS OF GUARANTEED FUNERAL DEPOSITS

A Prepaid Guaranteed Funeral Contract is completed with all costs itemized. Funds received are deposited through Guaranteed Funeral Deposits of Canada (Fraternal)

2. TO MAKE PARTIAL PAYMENTS

To suit your budget, Guaranteed Funeral Deposits of Canada (Fraternal) offers 1 through 10 year payment plans. A limited death benefit is offered for the first 24 months, depending on the time payment plan.

3. TO PREPAY BY MEANS OF A TRUST ACCOUNT.

A Prepaid Guaranteed Funeral Contract is completed with all costs itemized. Funds received are placed in trust with Guaranteed Funeral Deposits of Canada (Fraternal) and are invested in Canadian Guaranteed Investment Certificates.

With either prepayment option, if you have prepaid the guaranteed funeral contract in full, the interest that accumulates on the prepaid funds is applied to the total cost of the funeral at the time of need. Any excess funds will be returned to the estate of the deceased person. If the funeral has been fully prepaid and there are not sufficient funds when the services are provided, Turner & Porter will absorb the shortfall as the funeral has been guaranteed as described in the contract.

4. TO PREARRANGE WITHOUT PREPAYING.

All of your instructions are on file at the Turner & Porter Chapel of your choice. The funeral services are provided at the time of need with the price schedules in effect when the death occurs.
